

TO THE TROOPS WEEK CAMPER:

TO THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN:

We would like to offer you a FREE week at camp sponsored by the Minnesota Elks! To register your child (ages 9-13) for camp you will need to call Tom Kramin at 320-292-5996. Then you will need to print the registration form and medical form from the troops week link on the website and send them to him.

Transportation to the Camp is the responsibility of the parents for TROOPS Week. Registration will be on Sunday between 1:00 and 3:00. You will need to pick up your child by 9:00am on Saturday. Driving directions can be found on the website.

Daily mail service is provided at Elks Camp and we suggest that you do write. Please mail early in the week so the camper will receive the letter while still at camp. Write "happy news" as opposed to "I miss you" because the camper reacts much more positively to that type of mail. Your child will not have access to computers or email.

It is important for your child's safety and welfare that we have COMPLETE and ACCURATE information on all forms. Be sure that the forms are signed in the appropriate places by you, and the examining physician.

Please be assured that your child is safe and well taken care of. Our staff to camper ratio is 1:4 and we employ many teachers and college graduates.
